



Yunogawa
In the Edo period, hot spring towns developed around public bathhouses. Hot spring inns surrounded the public bathhouses and the visitors stayed for a long period of time, regularly going to communal bathhouses and sometimes taking a walk in the nature. These communal bathhouses are called Soyu and the townscape that developed around Soyu is called Yunogawa in the Hokuriku region.

Onsen Foot Bath

Rest your feet at this hot spring foot bath. Perched on top of the rock at the center is Yatagarasu, a three-legged sacred bird that appears in the legend depicting the beginning of Yamashiro hot springs.

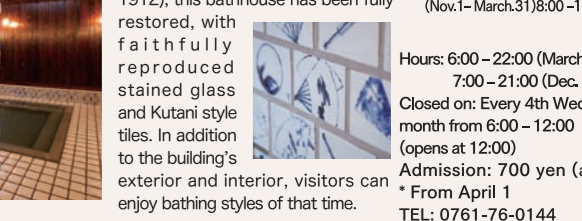
Soyu Bathhouse

A bathhouse featuring a vaulted ceiling with a large skylight and walls decorated with strips of hand-painted tiles by local Kutani ware artists. Each strip has a unique design! Try the popular "hot spring egg" soft-serve ice cream.

Kosoyu Bathhouse

Built in the Meiji period (1868 - 1912), this bathhouse has been fully restored, with faithfully reproduced stained glass and Kutani style tiles. In addition to the building's exterior and interior, visitors can enjoy bathing styles of that time.



Iroha Soan: The Temporary Residence of Rosanjin

Going by the name Fukuda Taikan at the time, Kitaaji Rosanjin lived in this building for about 6 months from the fall of 1915. Sections opened to the public include the workroom, study, room with a sunken hearth, tea room, and exhibition room (traditional storehouse).

Kutani-yaki Kiln Museum



Highlights include the ruins of a Kutani ware kiln built during the Edo period (1603 - 1868) and Japan's oldest remaining climbing kiln. Paint a pottery in the Kutani style or make pottery with a potter's wheel at an old house that had been used by a family of potters as their residence and studio for generations.

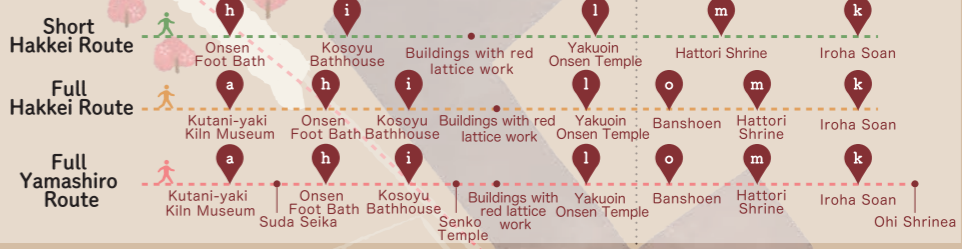
